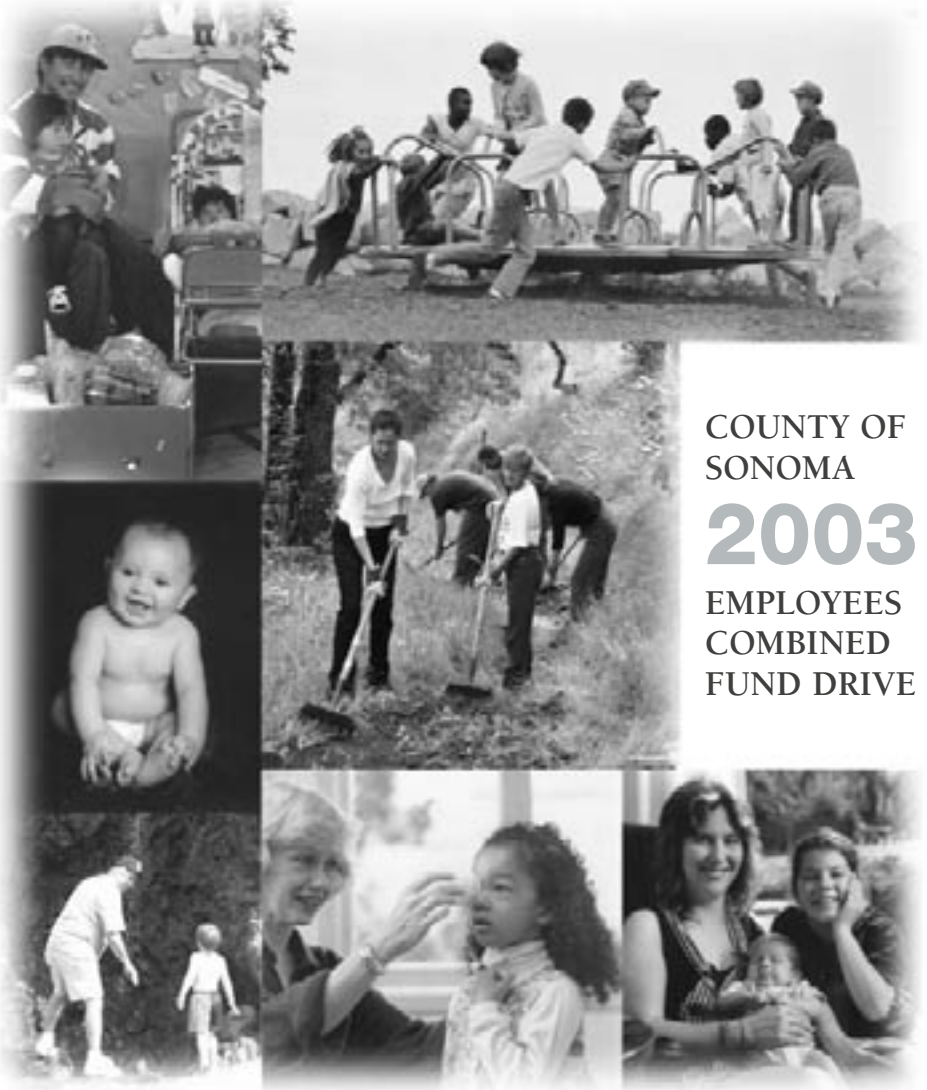

enables a librarian to bring the Sonoma County Library Summer Reading Program to young YMCA campers who could not otherwise participate in it

\$10 per pay period

buys materials for students and teachers for two visits to urban wildlife refuge, giving children first hand experience to learn about ecology and interdependence

\$4 per pay period

trains one leader to teach warm water exercises to people with arthritis, providing safe, healthy exercise to people with limited capacity.
